THE SOUTH

CHALK

Dover Main: between Sentiera Luminosa and The Verdant Tube inclusive. 1 Mar – 31 Aug. Between Some Like it Hot and The Tube inclusive. 1 Feb – 31 Aug

Dover North: between The X Files and Houdini inclusive. 1 Mar – 31 Aug

Isle Of Wight

Sun Corner and the headland at the SE end of Scratchell's Bay (including Gateway to Heaven and Albatross where it passes Sun Corner). 1 Mar – 31 Jul. A year round restriction applies to Highdown Cliffs (East of Sun Corner) for ornithological and botanical reasons.

Beachy Head

A peregrine nests at Beachy Head. Contact the **Ranger** (T: **01323 415267**) to check access arrangements. *1 Feb – 30 Jul*

Saltdean
Contact the BMC to see if nesting restrictions apply.

Contact the **Diffe** to see in resting restrictions apply

SWANAGE Between 1 Mar – 31 Jul:

Pier Bottom to Slippery Ledge: between Pier Bottom (the valley north of St Aldhem's Head) to the east arête of *The Yellow Wall* and from *Buttery Corner* to *Slippery Ledge*.

Seacombe: all routes on The Gallery.

Hedbury Quarry to Dancing Ledge: all routes at Hedbury Big Cove, Smokey Hole, Topmast Quarry and Hidden Ledge. Guillemot Ledge: all routes from Dancing Ledge to Valkyrie

Buttress Direct and east of *The Razor's Edge*. Cormorant Ledge: all routes west of *Sea Cow* and east of *Oran*.

Blackers Hole: all routes west of *Frontiersman* (including the sea cave). Boulder Ruckle: all routes from *Andycap* to *Raindrop*, *Sardine Special* to *Hard Day's Night*, and *Quasimodo* to *Insectitude*.

The Lighthouse Cliffs: all routes from *Scotsman Chimney* to the start of *Traverse of the Gods*.

Tilly Whim Caves to Durlston Head and Tilly Whim Quarry: climbing is not permitted year round due to ornithological, ecological and safety concerns.

PORTLAND

The following restrictions may change depending on where the birds nest – please check the **RAD** or contact the **BMC** for any updates. **West Weares:** north of Pit Prop Crag there is a total voluntary ban as this is a sanctuary zone for nesting birds.

Blacknor: Death of Cool to Ocean Drive inclusive. 1 Mar – 30 Jun Wallsend Cove: Empire State Arête to Beautiful South inclusive – look out for on-site signing. 1 Mar – 30 Jun

Coastguard South: Down to The Wire to the project right of Dawr

Borrowdale

Eagle Crag: unsigned – no restriction unless birds nest. Routes from *Dumbo Cracks* to *Trapeze* are not restricted. Upper Falcon Crags: signed.

Gillercombe: unsigned. From *Peregrine Way* to *Prudence* inclusive Gable & Pillar

Bowness Knot: unsigned.

Buttermere

Buckstone How: no restriction unless birds nest.

Dow, Duddon & Slate Raven Crag, Yewdale: signed – Western Edge scramble not restricted.

Stonestar Crag: signed. Wallowbarrow Gorge: signed

Scafell, Wasdale & Eskdale

Brantrake Crag: signed.

Eastern Crags & Outcrops

Raven Crag (Thirlmere): signed – the site is regularly monitored and restriction lifted if the birds don't nest.

Thackmell Crag: no restriction unless birds nest. Calf Howe Crag (Kentmere): signed – will be lifted if birds move.

Upper Thrang Crag: signed. Welter Crag: permanent restriction – call BMC Office for details.

South Lakes Limestone

Chapel Head Scar: signed - the site is regularly monitored and the restriction lifted if the birds do not nest.

Humphrey Head: signed.

Scout Scar: no nesting restrictions, however the crag is closed for shooting on a number of dates throughout the year – check RAD for details. White Scar: unsigned.

RAVEN RESTRICTIONS (BETWEEN 15 FEB – 31 MAY) Borrowdale

Lower Falcon Crags: signed – all routes left of *Interloper* except Spin Up. Restriction may be extended until 30 Jun if peregrine nest.

Eastern Crags

Buckbarrow: signed – restriction includes the scramble. Raven Crag (Threshwaite Cove): signed – restriction includes scrambles. Restriction may be extended until 30 Jun if peregrine nest. Raven Crag (Kentmere): signed – restriction includes the popular scramble. Restriction may be extended until 30 Jun if peregrine nest. Swarthbeck Gill: signed – restriction includes scramble and climbs

on *Long Crag*. Lower Thrang Crag: signed.

Black Force (Howgills): signed – applies to the popular scramble.

SEA BIRD RESTRICTIONS (BETWEEN 1 FEB – 30 JUL) St Bees Head

This area is an RSPB reserve, the largest sea bird colony in NW England, and home to the only Black Guillemot breeding site in England.

2012 CLIMBING RESTRICTIONS

GOING CLIMBING IN 2012? MAYBE A TRIP TO THE LAKES OR DAY OF ADVENTURE ON GOGARTH? REMEMBER TO CHECK IF THE AREA YOU'RE HEADING TO HAS ANY ACCESS RESTRICTIONS BEFORE YOU GO...

The UK is internationally recognised for its wintering, migratory and nesting birds and for over 30 years, the BMC has worked with conservation bodies, the RSPB, National Park Authorities and local ornithologists to agree reasonable voluntary nesting restrictions.

There is a general acceptance amongst conservation bodies and landowners that restrictions should be flexible, monitored and reviewed to ensure they are credible with climbers. It is important that climbers follow the agreed restrictions to ensure that future climbing access continues.

Restrictions can change during the breeding period, and the BMC's **Regional Access Database (RAD)** plays an important role in providing up to date access information for climbers. The RAD is a searchable database of all crags in England and Wales with special access and conservation considerations, including agreed nesting restrictions. Some restrictions are lifted early or may change during the nesting season, these are marked with a (**VR**) below.

SOUTH & WEST WALES

GOWER

Between 1 Mar - 15 Aug:

Southgate area: (VR) Bosco's Cave (aka Crow Hole) to Quartz Corner, inc. Bucketland. (Bacon Hole is permanently restricted). Thurba Head: (VR) Central Cleft to Wimp. Yellow Wall: (VR) 5 minutes to Kill to Early Warning.

SOUTH PEMBROKESHIRE

Range West

Subject to military training requirements, access will be available to Range West for briefed climbers from 2 Jun – 31 Jan 2013. Climbers must attend an annual safety briefing and hold a valid permit to access Range West. The briefings start at 9 am on 2 Jun, 23 Jun & 28 Jul at Castlemartin Camp. Restrictions may vary – check the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park leaflet and notice boards on approach paths. Between 2 Jun – 1 Aua:

Berry Slade to Western Walls: False Start to All Quiet on the Western Front.

Wind Zawn: Khamsin to Flatulence.

Strata Walls: Discovery to Listen With Mother. Impending Inlet, Linney Point: Impending Doom to All Hands to the Pump.

Hobby Horse Bay: Dawn Chorus to Crack of Dusk – this is a permanent restriction due to archaeological interest.

Cabin Door: Scrambler. Mount Sion Central: Take Me Into Insanity to X-rated. Mount Sion East: Mein Smurt to Come All Ye Faithful.

Flimston/Perimeter Bay: Hermit to Life's Rich Pagent. Range East

Between 1 Mar - 1 Aug:

Stack Rocks Area: Green Bridge to Flimston Ridge including The Cauldron. For Elegug Stacks only, **1 Mar – 15 Aug** Thunder Wall: Thunderdome to Thunderbird.

Mewsford SW Face: Undercracker to Getting Involved.

Mewsford Arches West: Brain Drain to Stegosaurus. Mewsford Arches East to Panzer Walls: Speakeasy to Helen's Horror.

Seaside Gully/Triple Overhang/Ripper Cliff: Fight the Good Fight to Midnight Express (access to Horoscope to Galactic Coordinator by direct abseil only). Star Control to Rabbit Ripper.

The Fortress: Wild Country & High Country to Little Red Rocket. Castle East Blow Hole: all routes.

Devil's Barn: all routes.

Huntsman's Leap: Charbydis to Leap of Faith.

Trevellen: *Meatloaf* to *Breaking the Habit.* **St Govan's Head:** *Safety in Numbers* to *Aquarius.*

Rhiw Area Bytilith: Three Caves Zawn. 1 Apr – 31 Jul

Cilan Area

Climbers should be wary of nesting ravens and avoid if present. This area is complex and climbers should check the **RAD** for current restrictions. Between 1 Apr – 15 Jul:

Cave North of Trwyn Melyn to Trwyn Melyn: all routes. Cave right of Real Macaw to headland: all routes.

Cannon Zawn: all routes. Trwyn Carreg y Tir: left of *Spike's Route* onlv.

Trwyn y Fulfran: all routes.

Paitsh: left side up to and including Hornblower, but routes to be accessed direct by abseil from stakes north of Snakey

China Town: all routes.

Black Bay: all routes.

Beasley Street area: all routes.

Through Cave Area: all routes.

Zawn 1: all routes.

Cilan Main: all routes.

Three Caves Bay: all routes. Zawn 2: all routes.

Multi Storey Walls to Vatican Zawn: all routes.

BERRY HEAD

Please check the **RAD** for the latest information at Berry Head. Restrictions apply to the following:

White Rhino Buttress: *Barnacle Traverse Continuation*; The Oz Wall; ledges above Oz Wall; beyond the Terminal Zawn; The Great Cave; Bismark Wall. Markers have been positioned at the ends of 'open' sections and these can be checked by contacting the **Berry Head Rangers Office** (T: 01803 883262/882619 or 07770 728666). *1 Mar – 31 Jul*

LUNDY

Lundy Island has extremely important seabird populations and a number of the cliffs have bird restrictions. Restrictions vary annually so climbers should check the guidebook before visiting and obtain the leaflet available on arrival. For information contact the **Lundy Warden** (T: 01237 431831). 1 Apr – 31 Jul

BAGGY POINT

Restriction covers the whole area between Scrattling Zawn and Slab Cove and is reviewed mid-season (late April/early May). White markers define the restricted areas (VR). Contact the **BMC** or **National Trust Warden** to check (T: 01271 870555).

THE NORTH

LAKE DISTRICT/CUMBRIA

PEREGRINE RESTRICTIONS (BETWEEN 1 MAR - 30 JUN)

Routes:

The main bolted areas of Apiary Wall and Scabby Back are unrestricted. All other areas including Fisherman's Steps are restricted.

Bouldering:

Apiary Wall and the boulders immediately at the foot of Fisherman's Steps: unrestricted; Boulders to south of Fisherman's Steps: restricted; Fleswick Bay: (south of inlet, where the path meets the shore): unrestricted; South Head: restricted.

YORKSHIRE

The Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority monitor the nest sites and restrictions are lifted as soon as the chicks fledge.

Derby Delph: all routes. 1 Mar - 30 Jun

Langcliffe Quarry: check RAD for full details. 1 Feb – 30 Jun Malham Cove: check on site signs. 1 Mar – 30 Jun

Blue Scar: all routes. 1 Mar - 15 Jul

High Stoney Bank: all routes. 15 Feb - 31 May

LANCASHIRE/CHESHIRE

Warton Main Quarry: (VR) may apply – check on site signs. Hoghton Quarry: check with the BMC prior to visiting and on site signs. Helsby: Upper Central Buttress area – (VR) can apply, check on site signs. 1 Mar – 30 Jun

PEAK DISTRICT

Roaches/Hen Cloud: (VR) depending on nest site. The Peak District National Park Authority monitor the site and lift the restriction as soon as the chicks fledge. Check on site signs.

Ravensdale: (VR) check on site signs.

Garston Rocks: (VR) can apply, check on site signs.

Millstone: (VR) signed on site and at Surprise View car park.

Stackpole Hd West, South and East Faces: The Cooler to Poisoned Love.

Stackpole Far East: Seoul Survivor to Thai-pin Wall, Blow Hole Zawn.

Mother Carey's Kitchen: restrictions may apply on *Stargate*, *Hyperspace* and *Warp Factor*, check for signs on approach path.

NORTH PEMBROKESHIRE

Between **1** Mar – **1** Aug all routes on the following cliffs are restricted: Needle Rock (Fishguard); Llechdafad; Penbwchdy; Ynys Deullyn; Ogof Mrs Morgan; Dinas Fach (Solva).

MID WALES

Llanymynech: Red Walls and Black Walls. *1 Mar – 30 Jun* Craig yr Aderyn (Bird Rock): Eastern Face and Central Buttress. *1 Apr – 31 Jul*

Barmouth Quarry: all routes. 1 Mar - 31 Jun

NORTH WALES

Gurn Ddu Quarry: all routes. 1 Apr – 31 Jul Craig y Llam: all routes. 1 Feb – 31 Jul Craig Gallt y Ceiliog: all routes. 1 Apr – 31 Jul

Little Orme

Un-named crag; Castell y Gwynt: left side only, but whole cliff is restricted if signs in place on approach path; Craig Pen Gogarth: upper and lower; Point Five Buttress; Hornby Crags: Crescent Buttress only. 1 Mar – 1 Aug

Upper Pen Trwyn, and all crags directly above the Marine Drive are subject to a summer safety restriction. No climbing allowed before 6 pm during school holidays (15 Jul – 8 Sep) and all bank holiday weekends.

GOGARTH

Dates may change depending on when birds start nesting – check for on-site signs and RAD. Between **1** Feb – **31** Jul, all routes in the following areas:

Mousetrap Zawn; Red Walls; Penlas Rock; Smurf Zawn; Blacksmith's Zawn; South side of South Stack Island.

North Stack (Flytrap area): 20,000 Leagues to Seal Song.

The Range (Dichotomous Wall area): Dai on Demand. 1 Mar - 30 Jun.
