- Gloves must be worn by all competitors.
- Stiff soled mountaineering boots must be worn.
- Crampons will ONLY be used for the Glenmore Lodge round. All indoor venues will be just boots.
- Axes must have their adze and hammer heads removed. If this is not possible, they must be covered over securely with foam, taped into place.
- Axe leashes must be removed.
