Terms of Reference

The membership and terms of reference were reviewed and agreed by the National Council at its meeting on 1 December 2007:

The role of the Competitions Committee is to formulate policies and advise the National Council upon all aspects of competition climbing and mountaineering. The Competitions Committee will be responsible for the following:

1. Oversee the development of competition climbing in Britain.
2. Be responsible for the organisation and promotion of the various British Climbing Championships, including setting the rules.
3. Support international competitions held under IFSC (International Federation of Sport Climbing) rules in Britain.
4. Select and organise a GB team to compete in international events and assist in making the necessary travel and accommodation arrangements in accordance with the BMC's policies and procedures, taking particular note of the BMC Child Protection Policy, when team members are under the age of 18.
5. Oversee the development of training programmes for competition climbers and coaches.
6. Run training and assessment schemes for competition officials.
