BMC Voting at AGM

- If you are over 18 years of age and a current member of the BMC you are entitled to one vote per agenda item at the BMC AGM.
- If you attend the AGM in person your one vote is counted by a show of hands.
- If you are unable to attend the AGM, you can nominate a Proxy to cast your vote on your behalf.

Proxy Voting

- To allow another BMC member to vote on your behalf at the AGM you must complete the proxy voting form that is found in the March edition of Summit.
- The proxy voting form must be received by the BMC office 48 hours prior to the AGM for it to be valid.
- Your Nominated Proxy must attend the AGM in person to allow your vote to be counted.
- If you do not stipulate the direction of your vote, then your Nominated Proxy can use your vote as they see fit.
