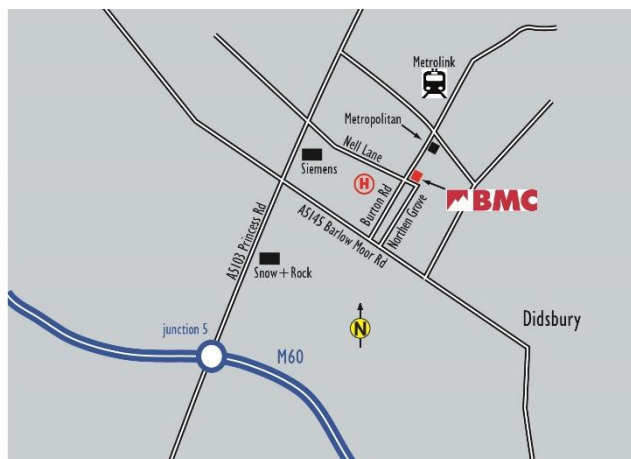

## How to find us

### Location

The BMC office is situated in a former church in West Didsbury, South Manchester on the corner of Burton Road and Northern Grove and is easily reached by both car and public transport.

### By Train

The closest train stations to the BMC office are East Didsbury and Burnage, however the office is easily reached by bus and tram connections from major stations in Central Manchester (Manchester Piccadilly and Manchester Victoria) and Stockport (bus only).

### By Bus

Routes from Central Manchester, Manchester Airport and Stockport:

- 44 / 111 Piccadilly Gardens to Burton Road
- 41 Victoria Rail Station / Piccadilly Gardens to Palatine Road
- 143 Piccadilly Gardens to Palatine Road
- 43 Piccadilly Gardens / Manchester Airport to Palatine Road
- 42 Piccadilly Gardens / Stockport to Wilmslow Road
- 23 Stockport to Barlow Moor Road

### By Tram

The nearest Metrolink stop is Burton Road on the East Didsbury line.

Exit at the Burton Road stop and turn right down Burton Road. The BMC office is a 3-minute walk passing Tesco Metro, over the lights and towards Withington Community hospital.

### By Car

1. From Manchester, follow signs for Manchester Airport onto Princess Road (A5103), turning left into Nell Lane (just before the Siemens Building). Continue to junction and the BMC office is just opposite.
2. M60 from east, Junction 5 then pick up A5103 turning right onto Nell Lane.
3. M60 from west, Junction 5 which will take you south on the A5103. Follow signs for A560. Turn right at the roundabout and get back onto the A5103 heading north.
4. M56 runs into A5103. Turn right onto Nell Lane (just after Siemens Building). Continue to the T junction, and the BMC office is opposite.

**Car parking:** There is no dedicated parking at the BMC office, and we are in a busy residential area with limited on-street parking. The Co-op store next door has a small short stay car park for customers (max. 45 minutes), and there is a Pay and Display car park at Withington Community Hospital (accessed from Nell Lane).
