<b>Terms of Reference</b>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be responsible for the compilation, publication and distribution of definitive and select rock climbing guides to the Peak and Pennine Area and any other areas which may fall within the remit of the committee (e.g. Cheshire, Lancashire).</li> <li>2. Create and maintain a historical record of the climbs within the committee's area of responsibility.</li> <li>3. To communicate with and be cognisant of wishes and direction from the relevant BMC local areas.</li> <li>4. To work closely with other BMC functions such as Access, Conservation and Environment Group to promote good practice within the areas covered in its guidebooks.</li> <li>5. To offer financial and technical assistance to other guidebook and publishing related projects.</li> <li>6. Create, maintain and support the Wired network of guidebook collaborators across the UK</li> <li>7. Oversee the migration of ownership of Wired national route database to the BMC.</li> <li>8. Adopt and maintain the Wired database platform.</li> <li>9. To support the data creation of the entire historical record for the UK.</li> <li>10. Enable the maintenance of the data.</li> <li>11.
