

INTERNATIONAL GUEST INFORMATION

BMC International Summer Climbing Meet

12 to 19 May 2019

Ynys Ettws, Llanberis Pass, North Wales

OVERVIEW

BMC International Meets are truly unique. They offer a great opportunity to meet a varied bunch of climbers from home and abroad, and make new friends. The Meet is located at <u>Ynys Ettws</u>, the Climbers' Club Hut in Llanberis Pass, North Wales. We stay here as guests of the Climbers' Club which owns the property. During the week guests from all over the world will be teamed up with UK host climbers, who will show them the full delights of British trad climbing. In the evenings presentations are given by both hosts and guests.

PROGRAMME OF EVENTS

- We will team you up with a UK based host climber each day and they will take you out climbing.
- Partnerships will be changed every few days so that you get to climb with different people.
- There will be an optional trad clinic (placing runners, building belays, belaying with two ropes) on the first morning.
- There will be several evening presentations throughout the week.
- On Saturday 18 May we will have a final night party with DJ to celebrate the weeks' climbing.

EXPERIENCE

Visiting climbers must have at least two years' experience of traditional lead climbing (experience with the placement and removal of protection).

VENUE & DATES

- Venue: Ynys Ettws, Llanberis Pass, North Wales
- Dates: Sunday 12 to Sunday 19 May 2019.
- Arrival evening: Sunday 12 May (no climbing on this day).
- Departure day: Sunday 19 May (no climbing on this day).

TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION

- You are responsible for making your own travel arrangements to the UK.
- Travel details will be sent to you mid-February when places are confirmed.
- The hut offers 'alpine hut' style accommodation with shared rooms and bathroom facilities.

COST

The fee is £180 per person and includes:

- Seven nights accommodation
- Three catered meals per day
- Nightly presentations
- Six days' climbing with experienced host climbers
- Optional trad clinic

• Transfer from Manchester airport.

HOW TO APPLY

- Federations (one per country) are invited to send a maximum of two climbers, ideally one female and one male, who must be a minimum of 18 years of age.
- IF THE MEET IS OVER SUBSCRIBED THEN PLACES WILL BE REDUCED TO ONE PER COUNTRY.
- Please complete the <u>online form</u> by **1 February 2019.**
- The BMC will contact all applying Federations by email by 11 February to confirm places.
- Please do not make any bookings (flights, trains etc) until you have had confirmation from the BMC.
