What to bring

To attend this workshop please bring the following desirable and essential equipment with you:

Desirable

A cordless screwdriver or impact driver with a 6mm and 8mm hex bits and a variety of screwdriver bits.

Essential

Suitable clothing and climbing equipment for bouldering. Food for the day (12pm – 8pm). If planning to buy food on the day please check any dietary requirements with the venue in advance.
