

Youth Climbing Series: Grand Final

Frequently asked questions:

Can those who haven't qualified for the Grand Final pay to enter?

No, you need meet the eligibility criteria in order to enter the Grand Final. Finalists will be notified after the fourth regional round has taken place.

If someone who qualified for the Grand Final can no longer attend, can the next in-line competitor take their place?

No, only the climbers ranked 1st, 2nd or 3rd in each category are eligible to attend the Grand Final.

What do I need to do before attending the Grand Final?

If you have any of the recognised covid symptoms, please follow the current [Government guidelines](#).

Please take a lateral flow test at least 24hrs prior to the Grand Final. Please send evidence of this, including a photo of yourself next to the test in a document, with your name on it to yca@thebmc.co.uk

Do I need to wear a mask in the centre?

Masks are not mandatory in England and are a personal choice will be recommending maintaining a 2m distance throughout the day where possible.

What happens if the final is cancelled due to COVID?

In the unfortunate event the final has to be cancelled, all competitors will receive a full refund of the event fee.

Will there be a podium?
