It has been produced by Ground Up, with support from Snowdonia Active and Snowdonia National Park.

### **Bouldering Bolts**

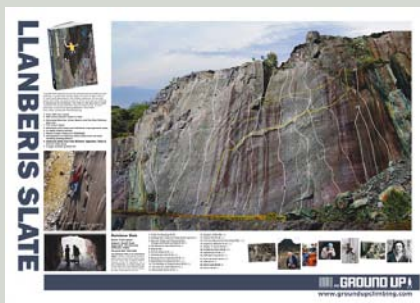
Yet again the winter aggregates at both the Beacon and Indy Climbing Walls have supported the North Wales Bolt Fund – giving all of the aggregate fees

In the wake of the warmly received Llanberis Slate guide Ground Up has produced a run of special edition Rainbow Slab topo posters with a view to boosting contributions to the North Wales Bolt Fund.

The A2 poster features a topo for the impressive Rainbow Slab, plus a few illustrative images and a Rogue’s Gallery of famous (or should that be: ‘infamous’) Slateheads.

The posters are available from V12 and Joe Brown in Llanberis, plus The Beacon and Indy Climbing walls for the bargain price of £2.95 - all proceeds will go to the North Wales Bolt Fund.



### National Trust

The NT recently introduced a programme called “The Ambassador Business Scheme”, which aims to increase the amount of formally organised outdoor activities on its land and properties. However there have been concerns that this is simply a way of licensing, charging and controlling use made by outdoor centres and providers of NT land, with a fear that “sole or exclusive” rights may be given to a preferred provider for some activities on some sites. BMC and Mountain Training have organised meetings to discuss this further and are hopeful of a successful outcome.

Also, what do members think of National Trust collection boxes in places such as Llyn Idwal and at the start of the Watkin Path - appropriate?

### Political Stuff

A good meeting was had between the BMC and the Environment Minister in Cardiff in early December. A number of items were on the agenda, including coastal access, the

proposed re-mapping of CROW access land, energy developments in mid Wales, and how the BMC can influence the forthcoming Natural Environment Framework Bill for Wales.

The outcome was that the minister has asked the BMC to produce a list and identify all coastal climbing sites where access is not “as of right” i.e. where we only have at best permissive or tolerated access or even where access is restricted. He has also since indicated that he would like to arrange a visit to some of these sites to see the issues and the BMC’s approach to managing conservation issues and conflict at these sites.

He has also instructed his officers to consult with the BMC to ensure that full consideration is given to include cliffs, crags and boulders which may have been missed out or BMC believes should have been included in the original mapping process for open access. He was less forthcoming on the issue of wind –turbines in mid Wales, stating that the responsibility for large energy projects currently lies with the UK government’s appointed quango the Infrastructure Planning Commission, and not the Welsh Government in Cardiff.



The Natural Environment Framework bill is out to consultation on January 30th, and BMC Cymru will be a formal



consultee. This new piece of legislation could have far reaching and long term impact on both the conservation and access to the countryside of Wales, as the Welsh government can now legislate as it sees fit in this area, and can change the existing regulations and laws such as CROW and Wildlife and Countryside Act without having to refer to Parliament.

## ACCESS

- Gogarth- Penrhyn Mawr/The Range/Yellow Walls

In anticipation of the new guidebook BMC will be providing new belay stakes here (in agreement with RSPB), and also if technically possible along the top of Yellow Walls at South Stack, to prevent climbers blocking the coast path with ropes.

- Dali's Hole

As stated in the last Area meeting, the proposed terms of a lease to the BMC for this site were unacceptable for legal reasons to the BMC, and could have left the BMC responsible for some long term liabilities beyond the term of the lease,

as well as adding to the amount of fencing at the site. The current situation seems to be continuing, but dialogue continues with First Hydro, and there are no recent reports of any incidents.

- Llyn Peninsula Meetings arranged with RSPB to review Chough sites near Aberdaron.

- Barmouth Quarry Now open for climbing, subject to seasonal restrictions to protect nesting birds.

- Reminder The annual Seasonal Climbing restrictions to protect nesting birds will soon be on us – check the BMC RAD for details!

## Snowdonia National Park

The proposed new Ogwen interpretation centre has been deferred and the planning committee has requested that the design be “toned down” before being re-submitted, which reflects the views previously put forward by the BMC.

## Footpath Works

Work is underway to place stone pillars, marked discreetly with the path names at the start of the main paths on Snowdon, and at key path junctions, replacing some of the existing stone pillars, with local stone. It is anticipated that this work will be completed by the end of summer 2012.

## Brecon Beacons National Park

The Park has requested a review and BMC input into the

access arrangements at Llan-gattock. BMC Access & Conservation Trust contributed to footpath repair works on the black Mountain to support being done by the National Park to repair eroded paths.

## North Wales Limestone - Photo Appeal

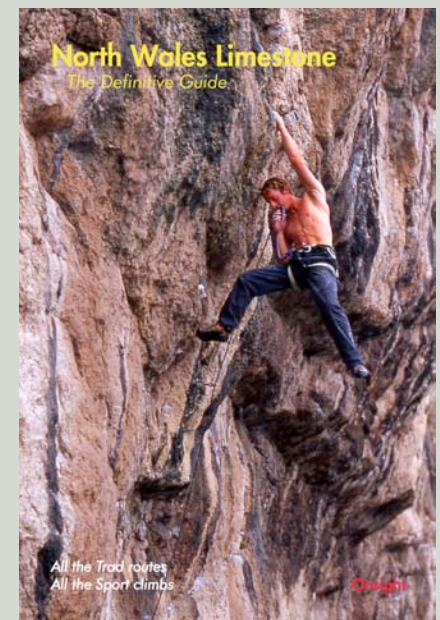

## Notes from BMC Training and Youth Committee(TYC)

Following the very successful event in 2011, there will be another Coaching Symposium on

the 24th & 25th March. This time it will be taking place at Calshott OEC and full details are on the BMC website.

Another successful series of events has been the National Academies for talented young climbers identified during the Youth Climbing Series (YCS). The BMC YCS format has been reformed to align our age groups with that used in European competitions; the finals will now be held over two days, rather than a frantic single day.

The Belaying/Abseiling Get It Right leaflets and Bouldering Sense posters have been revised and can be seen at numerous local climbing walls/cafes/meeting places.

Following a request by TYC, the BMC support for the Jonathan Conville Memorial Trust has been increased for 2012. Details of these courses can be seen on the BMC website.

The programmes for the Climbing Movement Masterclasses, the climbing FUNdamentals workshops and Alpine Lectures 2012, to be presented by Tim Neill and Nick Bullock, are now available.

Finally, TYC has been involved in the production of definitive guidance on the use of Fingerboards, with particular reference to under 18's.

The 2004 guide was the first (and to date, only) bilingual English/Welsh guidebook. However, the new book, by necessity, will be monoglot English; there are nearly 500 new items on [northwalesbouldering.com](http://northwalesbouldering.com) so there is a considerable amount of new information to be added to the original script. A bilingual guide would have ended up the size of a house brick!

If it all goes to plan the new guide will hit the shops before the end of 2012.

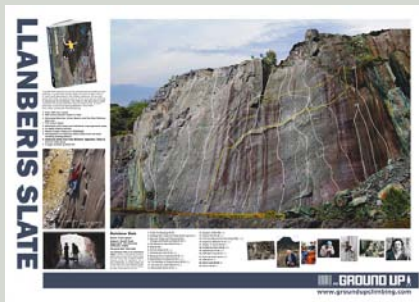
### **Bolltau Bowldro**
